

Our Member Protection Information Officer's name is Kate Harris. Member Protection Information Officers (MPIOs) are an integral part of all levels of Australian sport, especially grassroots sport. MPIOs are there to listen to issues raised by members of our sport before triaging and referring them to the right place to find a resolution. The MPIO is responsible for providing information about a person's rights, responsibilities and options to an individual making a complaint or raising a concern, as well as information support during the process.

MPIOs don't handle complaints or investigate grievances, and they don't mediate between members or stakeholders. They're also separate from the relevant Integrity Manager or the person(s) in authority regarding complaints, disputes and resolutions in our sport. MPIOs are an impartial party who are there to help guide people in the right direction. If you have any concerns please speak to Kate.
